Mar. 18, 1775, he was appointed on the Committee on Minute Men. Oct. 6 of the same Massachusetts State Archives, v. 66, pp. 491-498. year he was named as a member of the ff Committee of Safety, but was excused. On the 23d of the same month, he was appointed on a committee to procure materials to stop up passages into the harbor. This was after the authorities learned of the burning of Falmouth. He was chosen on the rf Committes of Correspondence, Inspection and Safety, at the Annual Town Meetings in 1776, 1777 and 1778. May 14, 1776, he was appointed to serve...
